### Residential Trip for Years 3 and 4

I am delighted to inform you that we have booked a residential trip to Grendon Hall for our Year 3 and 4 pupils from Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2019. This year we will be taking both year groups together as Grendon Hall are able to accommodate all of us at the same time.

We are looking into subsidising the trip using Sports Funding through government initiatives to reduce the total cost, but cannot guarantee this at present, so we will be asking for a voluntary contribution of a maximum of £150.00. As a reminder, please note the information overleaf regarding financial assistance.

With the above in mind, we now need to request that, in order to secure a place on this trip, you complete the attached slip and return it by **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> October**. A non-refundable deposit of £20.00 will need to be made online, via School Money for Denton and ParentPay for Yardley, by this date. (The facility for payment on School Money and ParentPay will go live later today, 24/09/18). Once a deposit has been received, you will be able to make monthly payments if you wish to spread the cost. Alternatively, you will be able to pay the remaining balance in 2 payments in December and March. If you have any difficulties making these payments, please let me know.

I would also like to reassure any children who are not going on the trip that we will organise a variety of fun activities across both schools during the dates of the trip.

## **Important information regarding school trips**

### **Please note:**

As part of the school's revised Charging and Remission policy, if a parent is experiencing difficulties in making the full contribution towards a trip, please talk to Louise Brown, in confidence, for assistance.

In addition, the school may be able to offer financial assistance towards the cost of a school trip and towards board and lodging on a residential trip, provided that a parent can prove that they are in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
