- Listen to some African music. Can you make a drum and create your own music? Can you create a dance to match the music?
- With some help, use Youtube to watch videos of different African animals and safaris.
- Make a model of an African house or create a picture or shoebox scene of the savannah.
- Can you learn to say anything in Swahili?
- Go to the library and find some non-fiction books about Africa or read some other books set in Africa. Can you spot any similarities or differences with Handa's Surprise.
- Linked to our Global week learning, plant some seeds and help them to grow.
- Think of some things you can do at home to help fight climate change.
