

Class and Year Group: Yardley Hastings – Year 3 and 4

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Sentence explaining curriculum</b>
English	This term we will look at diary writing. We will explore how a diary is structured and why they are written. Then, we will focus on the key skills required such as tense, conjunctions and how mood and feeling are created.
Maths	We will be looking at perimeter and area and how to identify this in shape. We will then move on to fractions.
Science	This term our topic of pollution will continue, however this will focus more on plants and the impact de-forestation has on the environment.
Humanities	With our term topic of pollution, we will continue to look at the impact this has on the local environment. We will compare living in our local areas to a big city and identify the impact this can have on living conditions.
RE	This term we will continue focussing on Sikhism. We will then return to Christianity as Easter approaches and use this as the engagement for the religion.
Art and Design	The focus this term will be on DT, which is inspired by our pollution theme as we are using recyclable materials to highlight the importance of recycling and the impact it can have. This is part of the home learning project we send home weekly.
Computing	We will begin by recapping e-safety and then we will move onto our understanding of word processes and PowerPoint.
Music	This term we will be working on our rhythm and listening.
PE	We will be working on our skills in both hockey and gymnastics, some of the children will be continuing their swimming lessons until the end of this term.
Modern Foreign Language (KS2)	This term we will be working on our speaking and listening phrases for greeting and number, working on the correct pronunciation of these.
