

Class and Year Group: Yardley Hastings – Year 3 and 4

Subject	Sentence explaining curriculum
English	We will be looking at non – fiction reports and exploring how and why they are written. We will then produce our own report on an animal we have created linking to our science lessons. We will then look at recounts and understand the difference between this and other text types.
Maths	We will continue our focus on number. Working on our methods for our calculations and securing our understanding. This term will focus particularly on multiplication and division and the relationship between them.
Science	This term our topic will animals and adaptations. We will explore how animals are suited to their habitat and see how this impacts on their classing and evolution.
Humanities	Our main focus will be history based on the Anglo-Saxons. We will continue to explore the impact they had on England and see how their beliefs were a focal point of their lifestyle.
RE	This term we will be focussing on Islam and the five pillars and then moving to Christianity exploring the religion around Christmas time.
Art and Design	The focus of the term is observational drawings.
Computing	We will begin by recapping e-safety and then we will move onto programming and our typing skills. Using programs such as Word, Publisher and PowerPoint and becoming familiar with how to use them.
Music	This term we will be working on our guitar playing skills as well as our understanding of pitch and tone through singing.
PE	We will be working on our understanding of physical fitness and the importance of keeping a fit and healthy lifestyle.
Modern Foreign Language (KS2)	This term we will be working on French and our speaking and listening phrases for greeting and number, working on the correct pronunciation of these.
