

Class and Year Group: Yardley Hastings – Year 3 and 4

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Sentence explaining curriculum</b>
English	This term we will re-visit narrative writing, where we will look to build on previously learnt skills as well as adding new concepts, such as character dialogue. Then, we will look at report writing through writing a letter, which will be inspired through our theme of pollution.
Maths	We will be focusing on multiplication and division. We will look at the foundation of each concept and then apply this into formal written methods. Following this, we will move on to measurement, looking at aspects such as length, perimeter and area.
Science	This term our topic will be around pollution. We will focus on scientific aspects such as: living things and materials.
Humanities	With our term topic of pollution, we will look at our local environment and compare it with larger areas in this country. We will then develop our understanding of the wider world and look at other climates and how pollution effects them. We will also look at how natural disasters have impacted pollution across the globe.
RE	This term we will be focussing on Sikhism. We will also be celebrating World Religion Week in January where the children will have different assemblies on a number of different religions.
Art and Design	The focus this term will be on layered art, using 'The Great Wave' as our engagement for this.
Computing	We will begin by recapping e-safety and then we will move onto our understanding of word processes.
Music	This term we will be working on our rhythm and listening.
PE	We will be working on our skills in both dodgeball and netball, building up to applying this into competitive games.
Modern Foreign Language (KS2)	This term we will be working on our speaking and listening phrases for greeting and number, working on the correct pronunciation of these.
