

Class and Year Group: Year 5 and 6

<b>Subject</b>	<b>Sentence explaining curriculum</b>
English	This term, we will be developing our ability to write recounts. We will write a variety of recounts, including newspaper reports, letters and diary entries.
Maths	During our number work, we will continue to work on addition and subtraction and using these when solving problems. We will then move on to multiplication. Alongside this, we will continue to explore shape. We will then begin to focus on position and direction.
Science	In science we will be learning about the life cycles of plants and animals.
Humanities	Our World War 2 history focus continues this term and we will be visiting Bletchley Park in November to find out more about the amazing work of the codebreakers. We will also be spending a little time learning more about World War 2 and the significance of Remembrance Sunday this year.
RE	In RE this term we will be continuing our work on Buddhism, including work on the Eightfold Path, Buddhist symbols and moral messages from Buddhist stories. We will also look at special celebrations in other religions, including Diwali and Hanukkah.
Art and Design	We are continuing with our drawing techniques and will be spending time at Yardley Arts developing these skills.
Computing	We will continue to work on our ability to use Scratch to code before completing further E-safety work.
Music	In music we continue to learn how to play the ukulele. We are exploring different music genres and playing tuned percussion instruments.
PE	We are currently enjoying athletics and looking at the impact of exercise on our bodies to link to our Science work.
Modern Foreign Language (KS2)	We are reading a variety of stories in French and continuing to learn poems. We are building our vocabulary and developing conversational language.
